### Describe your project

#### (1) What you did, (2) Why you did it, (3) How you did it, (4) Results and recommendations

(1) For over 100 years, "Diesterweg's Hulpkas voor behoeftige schoolkinderen" (Help for destitute schoolchildren) has been working for destitute schoolchildren of the city schools of Antwerp.

The financial support of needy schoolchildren of the city schools of Antwerp still continues nowadays. More and more families seem to be living on the outskirts of society. Unemployment, the quest for better living conditions in a foreign country, broken homes, insurmountable debts, ..., are the source of a less than enviable financial situation. The children are always the first victims.

Without making any distinctions whatsoever, the Diesterweg's Hulpkas tries to fill the gaps. The association supports the expenses for special holidays at the seaside or in the woods as well as contributing with the extra fees for playground attendance and holiday residences.

Diesterweg's Hulpkas helps in the utmost discretion.

(2) For the celebration of the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of SI Club Antwerpen we wanted to make a special effort to support effectively different organizations (9 in total) which are committed to the softening of the life of needy people in society, in Antwerpen and abroad.

(3) Several activities to collect funds were organised (theatre, concerts, selling of products, auction of peace dolls made by artists, etc.)

(4) A contribution of **1.500 €** was made to support the work of the Diesterweg's Hulpkas.

Project Costs: Estimated number of Hours Spent: the club members organised a number of activities (theatre, concert, selling chocolates, lanyards, decorated notebooks, auction of peace dolls made by artists, etc); in two years time, nearly 26.000 € were available for the 9 chosen projects.
